Kentucky State Board Certification/Licensure Requirements

The applicant must be at least 18 years of age, and must be able to document the following:

- Baccalaureate (sufficient for state certification as a substance abuse counselor) or Master's degree (State licensure requires 60 hour Master's program)
- Board-approved experience working with alcohol or drug dependent persons (300 hours of which have been under the direct supervision of a licensed or board approved certified alcohol and drug counselor who has at least 2 years of post-certification experience)
 - 6000 hours at the Baccalaureate level
 - 2000 hours at the Masters level
- 270 classroom hours of board-approved curriculum (satisfied by Union College 21 credit hour program)
- * Six hours of ethics training and 2 hours of training in the transmission, control, treatment and prevention of HIV (Satisfied by board approved workshops, face to face for ethics training).
- Passing score on written exam approved by the International Certification Reciprocity Consortium (IC&RC) on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse
- Signed agreement to abide by the standards of practice and code of ethics.
- The above are the KY requirements. Please check with the licensing or certifying board in your state for requirements.
